


STEERING HUB



Washer for use with Honda/Yamaha vehicles to compensate for vehicle manufacturing inconsistencies.

FROM THE TOOLBOX

Basic hand tools Hex keys Torque wrench Blue thread locker

NEED ADDITIONAL HELP?

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IMPORTANT

Read instructions throughly prior to installation. Installation should be performed by a qualified professional.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the wheels are completely straight before removing the OEM steering wheel.
- 2. Align the Assault hub so that the logo is at the top. It may be slightly off-center but top steering wheel bolt hole should be centered to the column Honda/Yamaha owners may need to install the washer in this step.
- 3. Finger tighten the steering column nut and add the steering wheel with a couple of bolts to hold it on. Now drive the vehicle forward several feet to ensure the wheel/hub is centered on the splines. If biased to the left or right, remove the center nut and adjust the position of the hub. Repeat this process until centered.
- 4. Using a torque wrench tighten the center nut to 30-35ft. lbs.
- 5. Install the steering wheel with plates blue thread locker can be used to in this step but is not neccessary.



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
